The South Louisiana Submerged Roads Program invites you to attend a neighborhood information meeting to discuss the repair and resurfacing of **MAGAZINE ST. (US 90B – ST. ANDREW ST.)**.

Construction on Magazine Street will begin in early January 2011. The primary focus of this informational meeting is to discuss construction and repair details and answer questions from the public.

Additional meetings will be held to discuss the repair and resurfacing of Magazine St. (St. Andrew St. – Napoleon Ave.) and (Napoleon Ave. – Nashville Ave.).

The \$6.7 million project will consist of removing two inches of old asphalt pavement, patching as required, placing back new asphalt pavement, curb repairs, new striping and markers, and new ADA handicap ramps. At some locations, storm water drain pipe repairs and other miscellaneous work will occur. The contractor for the project is Plus Concrete, Inc.

The \$118 million South Louisiana Submerged Roads Program is a comprehensive road repair program to repair and resurface roads damaged as a result of Hurricanes Katrina and Rita. The program is funded by the Emergency Relief Program of the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA). It is administered by the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development (DOTD).
